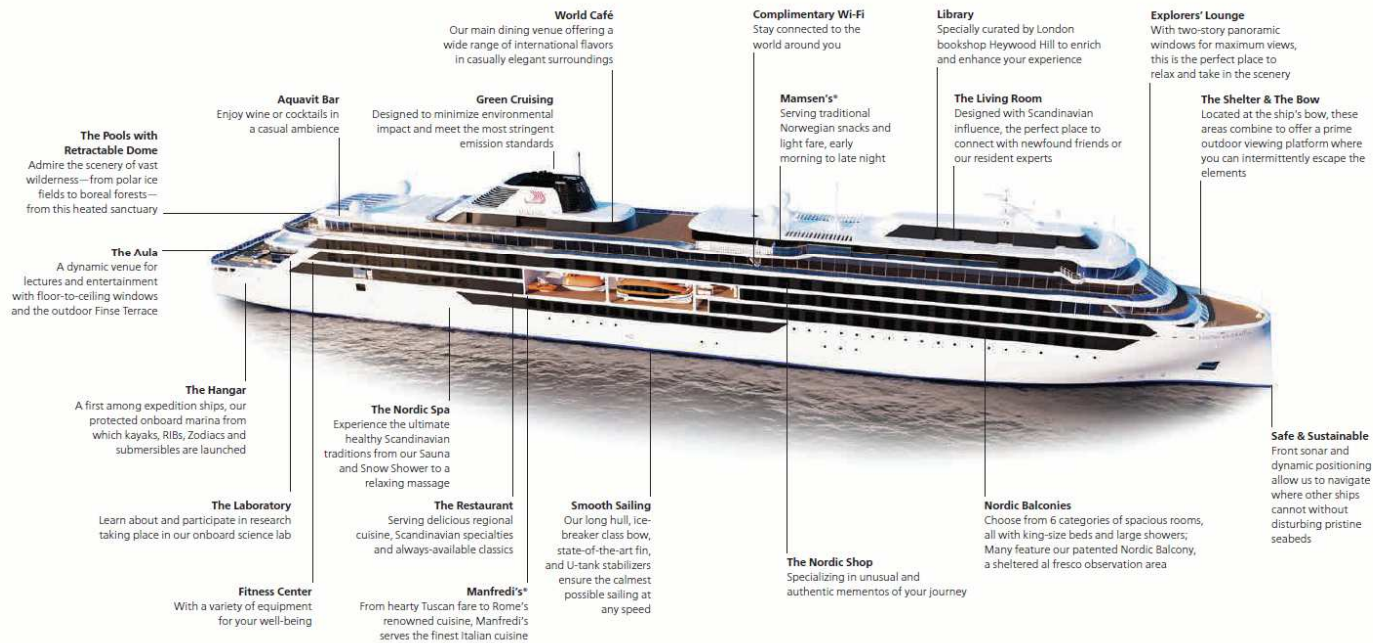

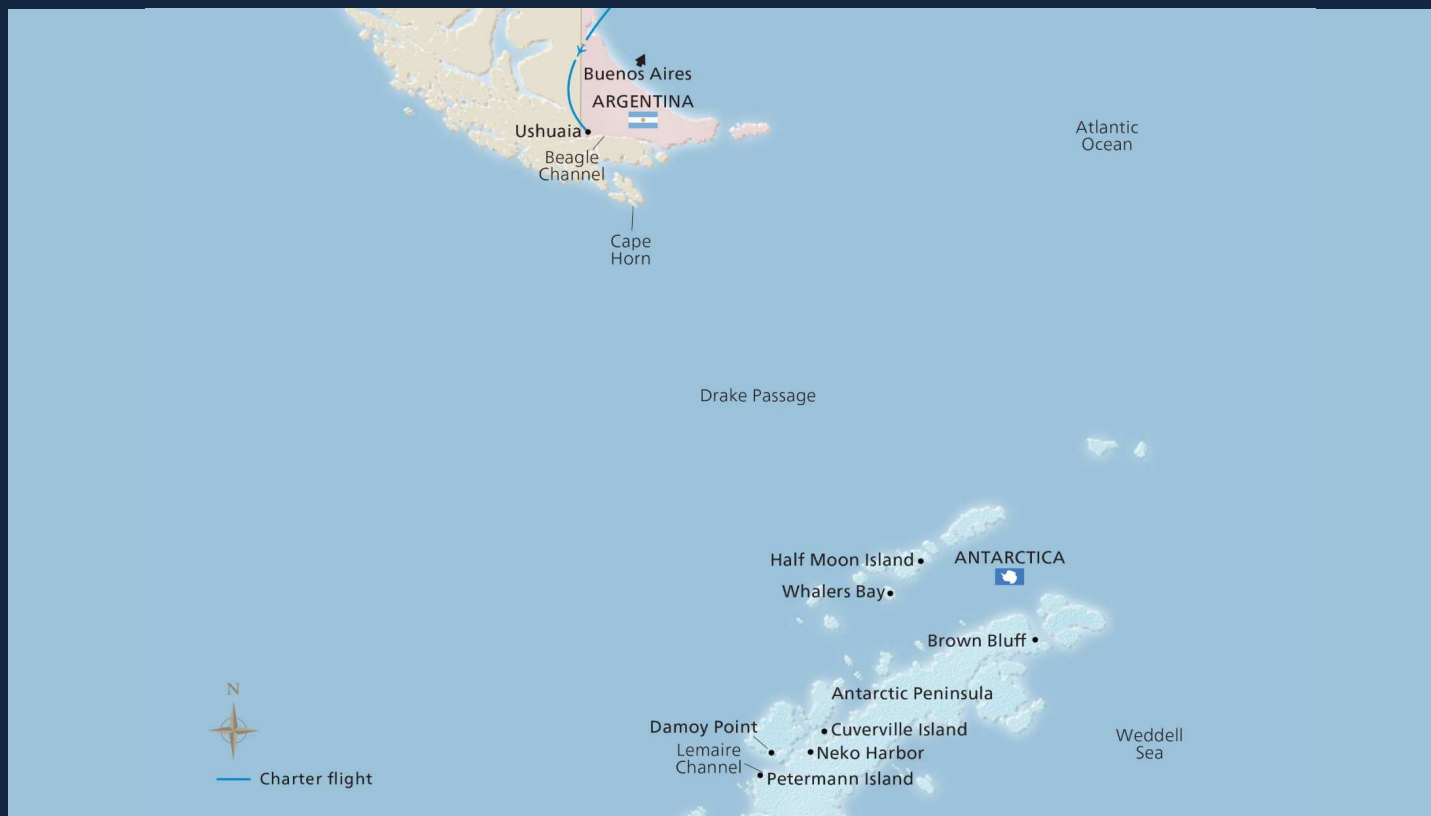

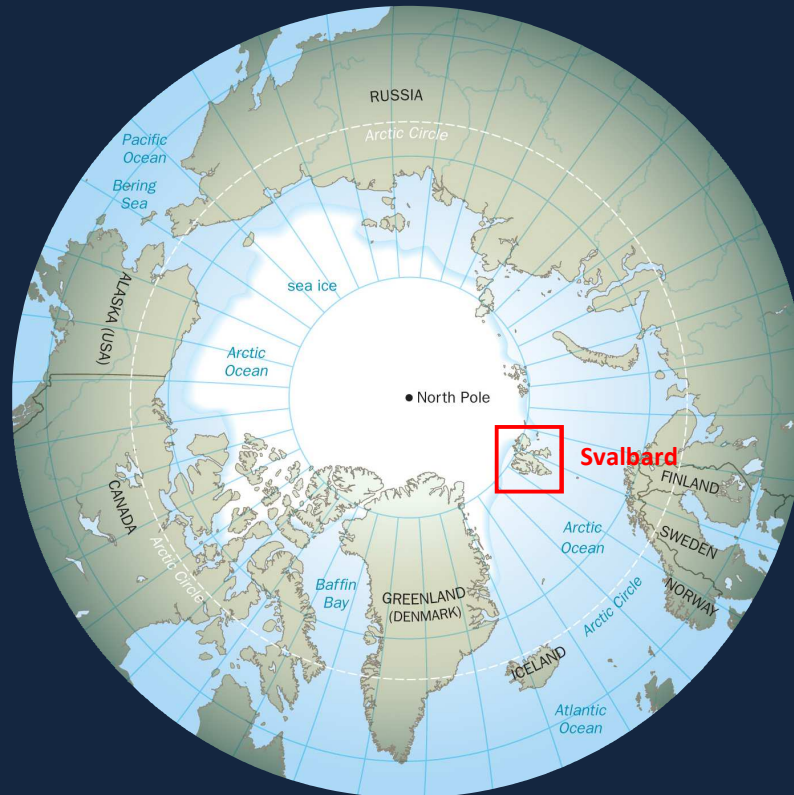

The Arctic

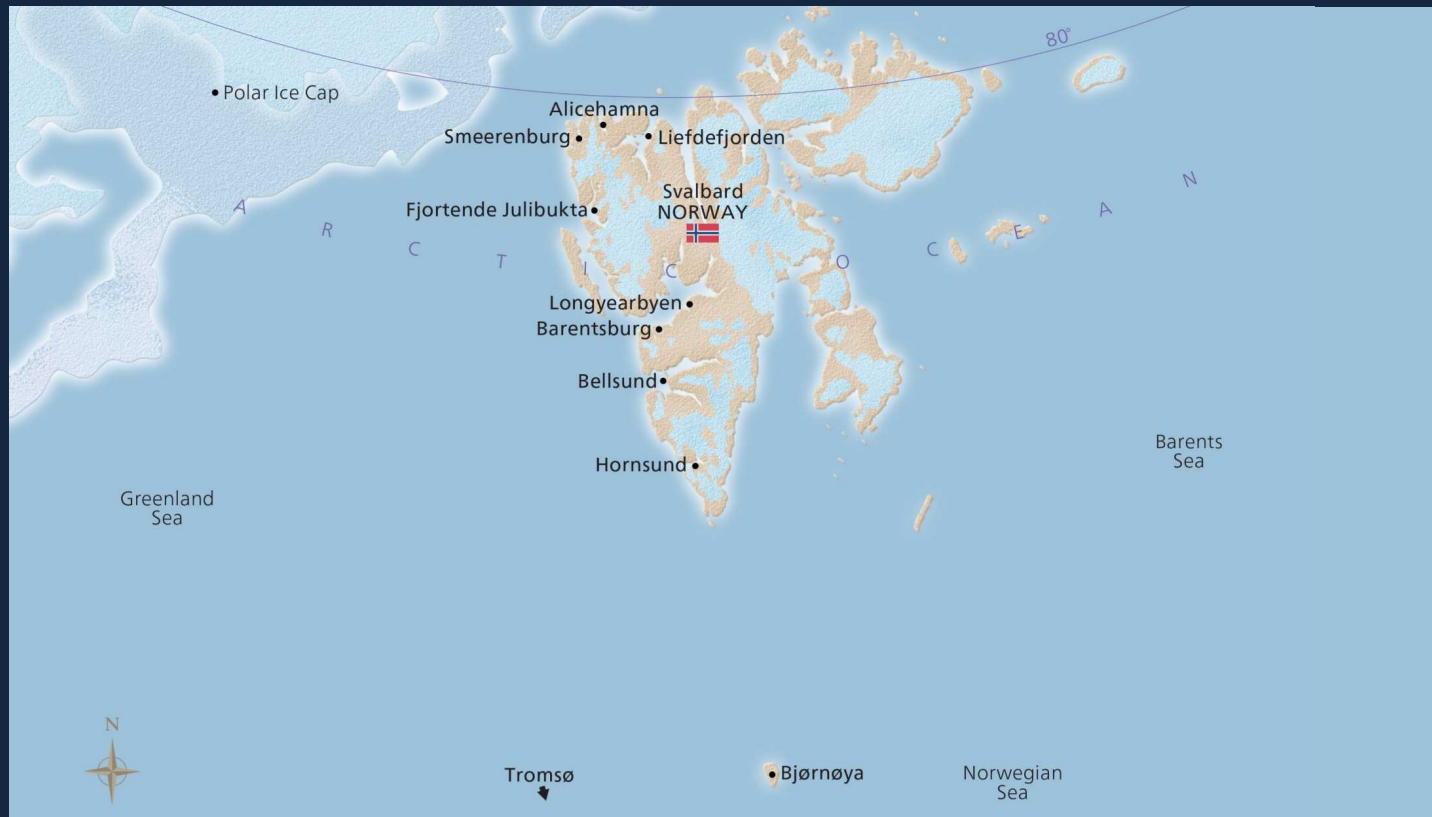

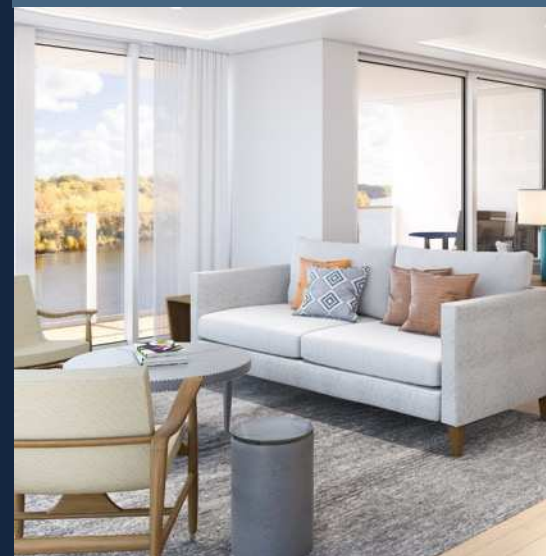
